The petitioner has renewed his prayer for bail in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302, 201, 120B/34 of the I.P.C.

Accusation is killing the daughter of the informant after six years of marriage for non-fulfilment of dowry demand.

From the report of the Superintendent of Police, Kaimur at Bhabhua and the learned trial Court, it appears that the trial is on the verge of conclusion.

In the circumstance, this Court is not inclined to interfere.

Learned Trial Court is expected to conclude the trial without giving unnecessary adjournment of either side.

The application is accordingly dismissed in connection with Sessions Trial No. 260/144 of 2012, arising

out of Chainpur P.S. Case No. 182 of 2011, pending in the Court of learned Adhoc Additional District Judge-III, Kaimur at Bhabua.
