A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the  
offence punishable under Sections 376(2) IPC and 4(1), 6 POCSO  
Act, 2012.

Allegation against the petitioner is to have committed  
the rape of the victim girl aged about 10-11 years.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the  
victim is not the informant. First information report has been  
lodged against the petitioner by the police personnel. The  
petitioner has no criminal antecedent and he has been in custody  
since 18.6.2013.

Learned counsel for the State submits that the victim

has been examined by the police and she has also made statement under Section 164 Cr.P.C. before the learned Magistrate in which she has narrated as to how the petitioner has been committing her rape. After investigation charge-sheet has already been submitted and sessions trial is going on.

Considering the facts and circumstances, in my opinion, the petitioner does not deserve bail at this stage. His prayer for bail is rejected.

Let the trial be expedited.
