ORAL ORDER

2 05-11-2015 This is an application, made under Section 439 of

the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-
petitioners, namely, Lal Babu Singh and Veena Devi, in
connection with N. H. Bangra Police Station Case No.47 of
2015 under Sections 304B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Perused the above application and materials on
record.

Heard Mr. Nilesh Kumar, learned Counsel,
appearing for the petitioners, and Mr. Nand Kishore Prasad,
learned Additional Public Prosecutor, appearing on behalf of the
State.

In view of the fact that the accused above-named
has been in custody since 15.07.2015 in connection with the
case aforementioned and though *charge sheet* has been



submitted, trial has not yet commenced and perusal of the materials available on record does not reveal such incriminating materials, which would warrant further detention of the accused-petitioners in custody, and in view also of the fact that the perusal of the materials does not reveal that the accused-petitioners' liberty on bail would adversely affect their trial, it is, in the interest of justice, hereby directed that the accused above-named shall be released on bail of Rs.10,000/- each with two sureties, each of the like amount, subject to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Samastipur, in connection with N. H. Bangra Police Station Case No.47 of 2015.

This direction for bail is further subject to the condition that the accused above-named shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer or tamper with the evidence and shall appear, in the learned Court below, as may be directed.

In terms of the above observations and directions, this bail application shall stand disposed of.
