Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and
the learned A.P.P. for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offence
punishable under Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468,
471/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is submitted that for construction of six rooms
of the school, the cost of the construction was estimated
Rs. 11,11,600/- and only Rs. 3.5 lacs was released by the
petitioner and at the place of occurrence four rooms were
completed and two rooms were found under
construction. The petitioner has retired on 18.2.2007.
After investigation chargesheet has also been submitted.
There is no chance of tampering with the witnesses. In
similar facts and circumstances, co-accused has been
granted anticipatory bail.

Considering the facts and circumstances of this
case, the above-named petitioner is directed to be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-
(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount

each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Lakhisarai, in Barahiya P.S. Case no. 126 of 2010 with the following conditions :

1. One of the bailors will be the close relative of the petitioner.
2. The petitioner will not indulge in similar or in any other offence.
3. The petitioner will be well represented in the court.
4. In case of absence for two consecutive dates or in violation of the terms of the bail, his bail bond will be liable to be cancelled by the court concerned.
