The allegation against the petitioner is of dragging the lady, tearing off her blouse and then attempting to commit rape upon her.

The submission is that the case was foisted against the petitioner as a counter blast to the case filed by the petitioner against the informant, vide Mansahi P.S. case No. 49 of 2014 under Sections 307, etc. of the Indian Penal Code. The submission was that the incident as alleged is unimaginable in the

heighbourhood relationship.

Let the petitioner Jai Prakash Yadav alias Jai Prakash Bharti be released on bail on his furnishing a bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Shri B.B. Rai, Judicial Magistrate, 1st Class, Katihar in connection with Mansahi P.S. Case No. 48 of 2014.
