ORAL ORDER

3 23-11-2015 This is an application, made under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, seeking bail for the accused-petitioner, namely, Sushil Kumar, in connection with Agamkuan Police Station Case No. 189 of 2015, under Sections 498A/323/504/302/34 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.
