The petitioner, who is languishing in custody, seeks bail in
a case registered under sections 379 and 411 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner is solitary named accused in this case on
being apprehended subsequent to taking away mobile and other
connected things of the informant, who could be able to apprehend on
suspicion and then produced said stolen articles before the police.

Submission is of false implication in a petty dispute
relating to queue for purchasing tickets. Further **petitioner carries no
criminal antecedents.**

If it is so, the petitioner above named is directed to be
released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten
Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of

learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, Begusarai in connection with Barauni Rail P.S. Case No.36 of 2014, subject to condition to remain physically present before the court below on each and every date till disposal of the case and in case of failure on two consecutive dates without giving any reasonable explanation, the privilege granted shall be deemed to be cancelled.
