The petitioner seeks bail in a case registered for the
offences under Sections 302/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that his brother Rakesh Kumar
and his wife assaulted the informant and his father. When the
informant came, Rakesh Kumar and his wife started pelting stones
on the father of the informant and father of the informant got
injury on his head and he fell down.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that from
perusal of the post-mortem report, it would appear that the
deceased got one injury on his head. The husband of the petitioner
is in jail and on account of single injury, the deceased died.

Considering the fact that the petitioner is a lady and

there is no specific allegation that the petitioner assaulted her father-in-law whereas the husband of the petitioner is alleged to have pelted stones causing injury on the head of his father, the petitioner, named above, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hilsa, Nalanda, in connection with Ekangarsarai P.S. Case No.103 of 2013.
