Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner is said to have established physical relation
with informant on false promise of marriage and subsequently,
when the petitioner got job in Police Department, he refused to
marry with the informant.

The submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the
informant has brought this false case against the petitioner with
intent to pressurize him so that, the petitioner could marry with her
and as a matter of fact, no such occurrence, as propounded in the
first information report, did ever take place.

Considering the above-said facts and circumstances of
the case as well as submission of the parties and also taking note
of this fact that investigation of this case has already been

completed, let the petitioner named above, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Gopalpur (Rangra) P.S. Case No. 190 of 2014 to the satisfaction of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Naugachia, Bhagalpur.
