4 08-10-2015 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as the learned A.P.P.

The petitioner seeks bail in a case for the offences punishable under section 392 of the I.P.C

It is submitted that the petitioner is not named in the F.I.R. He is in custody since 11.08.2014. No looted amount has been recovered from possession of the petitioner. Other co-accused have been allowed bail and only on the ground that the petitioner has got criminal antecedent his prayer for bail has been rejected. Charge sheet has already been submitted and there is no chance of tampering with the prosecution evidence and as such the petitioner deserves sympathetic consideration, to which the learned A.P.P. opposes.

In the facts and circumstances as stated above, as the petitioner has not been put on T.I. parade as yet and as such the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of S.D.J.M. Udakishunganj, Madhepura in Udakishunganj P.S. Case No. 78 of 2013, subject to the conditions that one of the bailors must be a near relative and another having sufficient immovable property within the territorial jurisdiction of the court concerned and the petitioner shall remain present on each and every date during trial and the default on two consecutive dates on his part without any reason shall disentitle the petitioner from privilege of bail.
