Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Muzaffarpur Town P.S.Case no.471 of 2015 registered under
Sections 419, 420, 468 and 471 of the Indian Penal Code.

While the petitioner was at the verge of retirement, his
Veterinary Officer, the informant under the direction of the State
has filed this case alleging therein that the petitioner disclosing
himself as a member of Kharwar community got SC/ST certificate
and obtained the degree. It is submitted that a departmental
proceeding was initiated and he has been dismissed.

Considering the aforesaid, this Court is inclined to
extend the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Let the

petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest/surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from today, be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Muzaffarpur in Muzaffarpur Town P.S.Case No. 471 of 2015, subject to the conditions as laid down u/s 438(2) Cr.P.C. with further following conditions:-

- (i) One of the bailors shall be the own/close family member of the petitioner.
- ii) In case of framing of charge, the petitioner shall appear in person on each and every date fixed in the court below. In case of default in doing so on two consecutive occasions without any cogent/satisfactory reason, the trial court shall have liberty to cancel the bail bond of the petitioner and secure his arrest in accordance with law.
