Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks bail in a case instituted for the
offence under Sections 304B, 201 and 34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Considering that the Petitioner is the father-in-law of
the deceased who claims that the deceased died on account of
illness, let the Petitioner above named, be released on bail on
furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- (Five thousand) with two
sureties of the like amount each or any other surety to be fixed by
the Court below to the satisfaction of Shri Umashankar, Judicial
Magistrate, 1st Class, Motihari, East Champaran, in connection
with Chiraiya (Shikarganj) P.S. Case No. 228 of 2014 subject to
the following conditions: (i) That one of the bailors will be a close
relative of the Petitioner who will give an affidavit giving

genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the Petitioner. (ii) That the Petitioner will give an undertaking that he will receive the police papers on the given date and be present on date fixed for charge and if he fails to do so on two given dates and delays the trial in any manner, his bail will be liable to be cancelled for reasons of misuse. (iii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
