Petitioner is not named in the first information report and it appears that after 30 days of the occurrence, Investigating officer filed a petition before the court for remand of the petitioner in the present case, though there appears to be nothing against him.

Petitioner carries criminal antecedent of several cases but submission on behalf of the petitioner is that petitioner has been remanded in this case only on the basis of suspicion and, as a matter of fact, when petitioner got bail in almost all cases, police got remanded the petitioner in the present case.
