ORAL ORDER

3. 11-08-2015 After some argument, Sri Alok Kumar Sinha, learned counsel for the petitioner, in presence of Sri Prashant Sinha, learned counsel for respondents/Employees Provident Fund Organisation, makes a prayer for disposal of the present petition so that the petitioner may avail statutory remedy.

The prayer is allowed.

It is made clear that if within a period of six weeks from today, the petitioner avails statutory remedy, the authority concerned shall examine the matter and decide the same on its
