3 15-05-2015 The petitioner being mother in law of the deceased

has filed the present application for anticipatory bail in a case

instituted under Section 304B/34 of the IPC and Section 3/4 of

the Dowry Prohibition Act.

It appears from the First Information Report that the

deceased was done to death within six months of her marriage in

the matrimonial home when the informant who is brother of the

victim had earlier wanted to meet her. The petitioner along with

other did not permit him to do so.

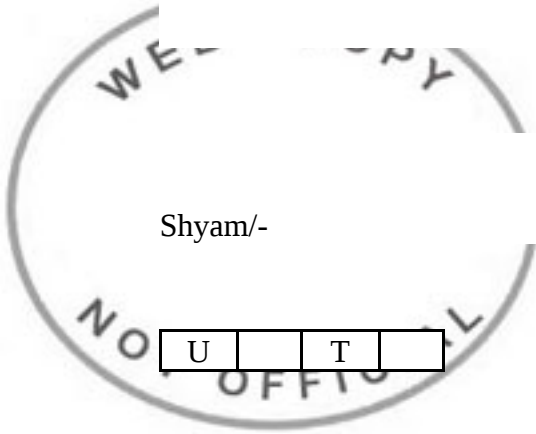
Mr. J.N.Thakur, learned APP, has placed the First

Considering the seriousness of the offence and the

allegations contained in the First Information Report as also the

facts reflected from the impugned order, in my view, petitioner
does not deserve anticipatory bail. The prayer is dismissed.
