2 04-02-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as
learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with
Goh Police Station Case No. 120 of 2014 registered for the
offences punishable under Sections 406/34 of the Indian Penal
Code.

Petitioner was Ex Chairman of Dadhapi PACS and
accusation against him that he did not deposit loan amount of cash
credit despite of issuance of several notices to him.

The contention on behalf of the petitioner is that in
cash credit scheme the bank issued cheque directly to the farmers
and after purchased of the paddy, the PACS supplies paddy to
Bihar State Food and Civil supply corporation of India from where
the cheque is directly issued to the concerned bank and therefore,

there is no role of Chairman of PACS in dealing with the cash. Moreover, two cheques of Dadhapi PACS are pending in the Bihar State Food and Civil supply corporation of India and the said cheques are not being sent to the concerned bank for which the petitioner has already filed civil writ before this Court.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, this anticipatory bail petition is allowed and it is ordered that petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the court concerned, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Daudnagar, Aurangabad in Goh Police Station Case No. 120 of 2014, subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
