A K Tripathi, J. The wife is also dead. The son of the ex-employee is
challenging the decision contained in Annexure-3.

2. He raises a question that he being the legal heir is also
entitled to a notice before Annexure-3 should have been passed.

3. The impugned order, contained in Annexure-3, will
remain in abeyance for the time being. Respondent authority of the
State is directed to issue a notice upon the petitioner and he is given

a period of three months to respond to the same and thereafter an appropriate decision, if required, will be taken afresh.

4. Writ application is disposed of with above direction.
