2 09-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Ishakchak Police Station Case No. 52 of 2014 registered for the offences punishable under Sections 385 and 387 of the Indian Penal Code.

Petitioner is not named in the first information report but it appears that one Alok Kumar was apprehended along with mobile, which had been used in the present crime and the said Alok Kumar confessed his guilt disclosed the name of the petitioner and except the aforesaid material there appears to be nothing against the petitioner. Petitioner does not have any

criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances as well as submissions of the parties, this anticipatory bail petition is allowed and it is ordered that petitioner, in the event of his arrest/surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order to the court concerned, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Bhagalpur in Ishakchak Police Station Case No. 52 of 2014 , subject to condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
