3 14-01-2015 Having heard counsel for the petitioner and the State, I am satisfied that petitioner does not deserve the privilege of bail in the event of arrest as he is named in the First Information Report along with others who presuming the deceased to be a witch poured kerosene oil on her person and set her ablaze causing her death.

Let petitioner, named above surrender in the court below within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of a copy of this order in the court below in connection with Rafiganj P.S. Case No. 189 of 2012 and apply for bail, which should be considered in accordance with law without being prejudiced by the fact that this Court has
