The petitioners apprehend arrest in relation to Mali Police Station (PS) Case No 8 of 2015 instituted under Sections 341, 323, 379, 307, 504, 506/34 of Indian Penal Code and Section 3 (i) (x) of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

It is submitted that informant is in the habit of lodging such cases for blackmailing and to collect money. Earlier also a case was filed which was compromised after taking Rs 25,000/- as compromise money. Otherwise there is hardly anything on record to justify the allegations.

Be that as it may, in the event of their arrest or

surrender within four weeks from today, the petitioners abovenamed shall be released on bail on each of them furnishing bonds of Rs 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Aurangabad in Mali PS Case No 8 of 2015 subject to all conditions as laid down in Section 438 (2) of Criminal Procedure Code.
