ORAL ORDER

2 23-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 341,323,427,504 and 506/34 of the Indian Penal Code and sections 3(1)(x)(xi) of the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act.

It is alleged that due to running of generator by the petitioners, the house of the informant was being damaged against which the informant made protest, whereupon the petitioners abused and tried to outrage the modesty of the informant.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that there was 107 Cr.P.C. proceeding between the petitioners and

husband of the informant. For the occurrence of 9.12.2014 the FIR was registered on 19.12.2014. Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned ACJM, Gaya in connection with Gaya SC/ST P.S. Case No. 102 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
