Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Writ application is required to be dismissed on the simple ground that there is no error apparent on the face of record either of fact or law. The above position has been amply laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of *Rajasthan Pradesh Vaidya*
