Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the
State.

The petitioner is apprehending his arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Section
406/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that the petitioner indeed with the
Munshi of the informant Niraj Kumar misappropriated
huge amount by misusing the four blank cheque.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the
petitioner that petitioner at earlier point of time filed a
complaint against the informant making allegation under
Section 138 of the N.I. Act and thereafter the present case has
been lodged.

Considering the nature of accusation and the
statement made in para-3 of the petition that petitioner has no

criminal antecedent, let the above named petitioner be released on bail in the event of his arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today, on furnishing bail bonds of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned In-charge Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jehanabad in connection with Jehanabad P.S. Case No. 342 of 2014, subject to conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Indian Penal Code.
