There is still statutory appeal provided to the petitioner under Section 24 of the Bihar Sanskrit Shiksha Board against the order of the Chairman as contained in Annexure- 19. From a reading of the order under challenge it is evident that the petitioner did not produce any of the documents in support of his claim. Why it was not done, it is for the petitioner to explain. Bringing certain materials on record in the writ application may not suffice. Those documents and authenticity thereof will have to be examined by the authorities, who are well versed with such issues. Petitioner still has a forum and

opportunity to overcome the decision of the Chairman. This Court expresses no opinion on the merit nor will interfere with the order of the Chairman at this stage.

Writ is disposed of with the above liberty.
