2 17-04-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the

State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case
registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148,
323, 329, 379 and 384/504 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that while the informant was feeling a ditch
on his land, the accused person demanded Rs.55,000/- and made
assault.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that
no injury was caused to the informant, a statement to this effect
has been made at paragraph 9 of the petition. A statement has also
been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioner has no
criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named

petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub-Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Raxaul at Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Adapur P.S. Case No.71 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
