03/ 22.05.2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State and also heard learned counsel for the informant.

Petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection with Sinhwara P. S. case no. 118/2014 registered under sections 302, 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

No doubt, informant is not an eye-witness of the alleged occurrence but para 16 of the case diary reveals that one witness claimed to have seen the petitioner committing the alleged crime.

Accordingly, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and hence, his prayer for anticipatory bail in connection with Sinhwara P. S. case no. 118/2014 pending in the court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Darbhanga stands rejected.
