dispose of the application dated 01.10.2013 filed by the

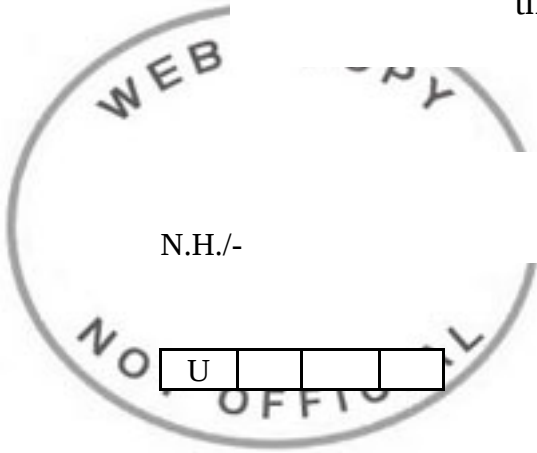
petitioner, in acknowledgment of which a receipt has
