Heard learned counsels for the petitioners
and the State.

Petitioners are apprehending their arrest in a
case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147,
148, 149, 307, 318, 323, 427, 452, 504 of the I.P.C.

It is alleged that when the police went to pacify the scuffle between two groups the mob attacked on the police as a result the police personnel got injured.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that accusation is omnibus and general.

A statement has been made in para 3 of the petition that petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the petitioners, above named, in the event of their arrest or surrender before the Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Saran at Chapra in connection with Marhowrah P.S. Case No. 321 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
