ORAL ORDER

2 14-05-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the
State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Section 147, 148, 149, 341, 447, 323, 324, 307, 504, 379 of the Indian Penal Code.

It is alleged that on protest being made by the informant for projecting window roof over his land by the accused persons, the informant was assaulted by co-accused Sanjay Prasad with 'farsa' when his father came to rescue then he was assaulted by petitioner Mukesh Prasad with iron rod, when mother of the informant came to rescue then the petitioners Rakesh Prasad and Pundeo Prasad assaulted her with 'farsa' and iron rod. It is further alleged that the wife of the informant was also assaulted by the accused persons and the accused persons

snatched jewellery of the wife of the informant.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that injuries have been found simple in nature. Moreover, the injuries are not corresponding to the accusation levelled in the FIR. There is counter versions of the occurrence also. A statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Motihari (East Champaran) in connection with Harsidhi P.S. Case No.206 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
