Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being the mother of the husband of the victim is apprehending her arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 201/34 and 304(B) of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the informant after four years of marriage for non-fulfillment of dowry demand.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the accusation is not specific against the petitioner and during investigation accusation has been found true only under Sections 306 and 201 of the I.P.C. Though final form has still not submitted.

Considering death of the victim after four years of marriage and the petitioner being lady, let the petitioner, above named, be released on bail in

the event of arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of twelve weeks from today in connection with Shahpur P.S. Case No. 347 of 2014 on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M. Bhojpur at Ara, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
