Heard learned counsel for the parties.

Location of a primary school is within the domain of the local authorities and the people whose interest it is required to serve.

It is evident from the counter affidavit that decision has been taken keeping in mind the proximity, the access and location, befitting the interest of the students etc.

The Court has no materials independent to such a decision to come to any other opinion.

Even otherwise, the Courts are not supposed to enter into such controversies and exercise its discretion under Article 226 of the Constitution of India.

In view of the aforesaid facts and circumstances, writ application is dismissed.
