This writ application is required to be dismissed because an illegal and irrational prayer has been made therein.

2. Father-in-law of the petitioner was a Government servant, who retired from the post of Hawildar from Bihar Military Police way back on 01.12.1997. The daughter-in-law claims herself to be the nominee and wants benefit of pay as per the recommendation of the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Revision Committee. The 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Revisions was introduced w.e.f. 1.4.2007. How does a retired employee or a nominee get a right for revision of pay is not

understood, especially when pension is being paid in terms of the revision.

3. Writ application is ill-advised. It is, therefore, dismissed.
