ORAL ORDER

2 17-03-2015 Heard learned counsels for the petitioners and the State.

The petitioners are apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 147,148,149,323,354,504,448 and 436 of the Indian Penal Code and section 27 of the Arms Act.

The accusation is of making assault to the informant and his daughter-in-law and putting the house of the informant on fire. The specific accusation of assaulting the daughter in law of the informant is against co accused Shashi Singh and Sanjay Singh whereas accusation of putting the house of the informant on fire is against co accused Ram Pravesh Singh and Amar Kishore Singh.

Petitioner no. 3 is alleged to have

pointed pistol on the temple of the informant and asked him to vacate the land in question.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioners that there is counter version of the occurrence. Statement has been made in paragraph 3 of the petition that the petitioners have no criminal antecedent. It is further submitted that the informant has retracted from the initial version and has filed a petition to that effect before the learned court below.

Considering the aforesaid facts, let the above named petitioners be released on anticipatory bail in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of twelve weeks from today on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned CJM, Motihari, East Champaran in connection with Turkaulia (Banjariya) P.S. Case No. 451 of 2014 subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
