Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and the State.

The grievance of the petitioner is that the respondent nos.5 to 8 have encroached upon the part of his private land and after demolition they have constructed pathway. He seeks

In my view, this writ application is not maintainable as in case of a private dispute proper remedy would be to move before a competent forum including a civil court of competent jurisdiction.
