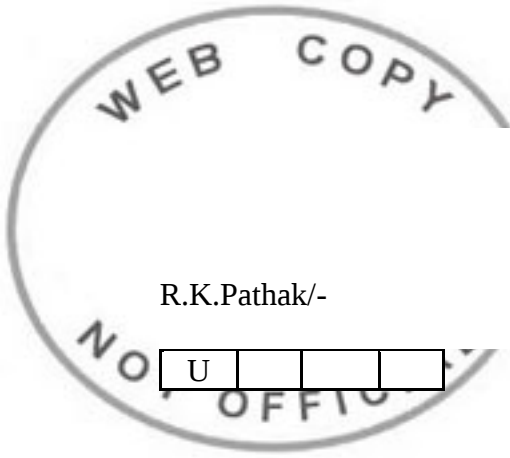
With the consent of the parties, all these writ applications were taken up together for hearing and are being disposed of by a common judgment.
