2 23-03-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

The petitioner apprehends his arrest in connection
with Complaint Case No. 923 of 2009 registered for the offence
under Sections-323, 377, 511, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The petitioner happens to be agnate of complainant
and the complainant has, specifically, admitted the aforesaid fact
in his statement. Moreover, the complainant has also admitted that
only his pant was removed. Moreover, other co-accused, having
more or less similar allegation, have already been granted
privilege of anticipatory bail by the learned Sessions Judge but it

is surprising enough that the prayer for bail of anticipatory bail of the petitioner was rejected by the same court, however, this anticipatory bail petition is allowed and the petitioner, named above, in the event of his arrest or surrender within four weeks from the date of receipt/production of copy of order in the court below, let the petitioner named above, shall be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs 10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each in connection with Complaint Case No. 923 of 2009 to the satisfaction of Sri Sanjeev Kumar-III, learned Judicial Magistrate-Ist Class, Siwan.
