2 19-02-2015 Let the petitioner file a suit for appropriate damages if the breach of contract has been committed by the respondents. The petitioner was appointed on contract as Physics Teacher for the purposes of OBC Girls Residential + 2 High School. On certain allegations by the girls with regard to his conduct, the respondent-authorities decided to terminate the contract. Such a decision

cannot be tested on the touchstone of Bihar Service Code or C.C.A. Rules, and the only remedy for the petitioner is common law remedy.

With liberty aforesaid, this writ application is dismissed.
