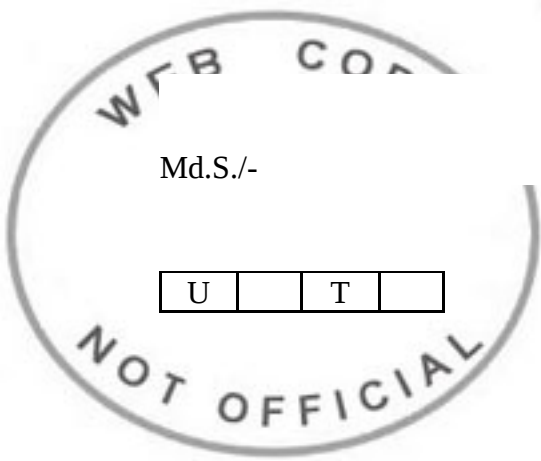
A counter affidavit has been filed on behalf of the State.
