2 02-03-2015 This Court will not interfere with the order impugned because the order speaks for itself as to why the removal of the private respondent was required to be interfered with. With such glaring violation noticed in the impugned order by the Management Committee, they cannot be permitted to be law by

themselves.

If the Managing Committee wants, let it move a civil court of competent jurisdiction, seek a declaration and also an order of restraint may be against the private respondent for functioning as a Principal in the College in question.

Writ application is otherwise dismissed since the impugned order does not suffer from any infirmity.
