02/ 27.03.2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned
Addl. Public Prosecutor for the State.

Petitioner happens to be father of the informant and there is
accusation against him that he attempted to outrage modesty of
informant's wife and when she made protest, petitioner set the house
on fire.

The contention on behalf of the petitioner is that no such
occurrence, as alleged in the first information report, had ever taken
place and, as a matter of fact, informant lodged this false case due to
family feud but later on, when he realized his mistake, he entered into
compromise which has been annexed with this petition as annexure 2.

Considering the facts and circumstances as well as
submissions of the parties, I do not feel it proper to extend the
privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner and accordingly, his
prayer for anticipatory bail in connection with Mohania P.S. Case no.

16/2014 pending in the court of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kaimur at Bhabua stands rejected.

However, if the petitioner surrenders and seeks regular bail within four weeks from today, the concerned court shall consider regular bail application of the petitioner on its own merit without being prejudiced by this rejection order, particularly, keeping in mind the relation of the petitioner with informant as well as fact of the compromise.
