Vishwanath Pandey was an exception not a rule. In the peculiarity of the facts and direction of the Hon`ble Apex Court, the State of Bihar has issued a resolution contained in Annexure-7. In view of the same, petitioners cannot seek parity. Their claim has to be decided in accordance with the prevalent rule governing compassionate appointment and the service rules related to them.
