2 26-06-2015 Learned counsel for the petitioner, prays for and is allowed to implead District Provident Fund Officer, Bhagalpur as respondent no. 6, to this writ application.

Having regard to the fact that the petitioner has a grievance as with regard to non payment of his amount of G.P.F., this Court would direct the newly added respondent no. 6, the District Provident Fund Officer, Bhagalpur, to examine the claim of the petitioner and if it is found by him that the amount of G.P.F., has not been

paid to the petitioner, that must be paid to him with statutory interest, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of this order.

For the rest of the relief sought in this writ application namely, arrears of sixth pay revision, arrears of third ACP and arrears of motorcycle allowance for the period 23.07.2003 to 31.03.2011, this writ application is not maintainable as they are not retirement benefit.

With the aforementioned observation and direction, this application is disposed of.
