4 13-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State.

This application for grant of anticipatory bail arises out of Arwal Mahila P.S. Case No 23 of 2014, disclosing offence under Sections 376 (2) (i) (j) of the Indian Penal Code and POCSO Act.

Keeping in view the gravity of the offence and the nature of allegation made against the petitioner, I am not inclined to grant the privilege of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, this application for anticipatory bail is, hereby, rejected.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the court below within six weeks and seek regular bail, if so advised. If he

does so, his application for regular bail shall be considered on its own merit without being prejudiced by rejection of present application for grant of anticipatory bail.
