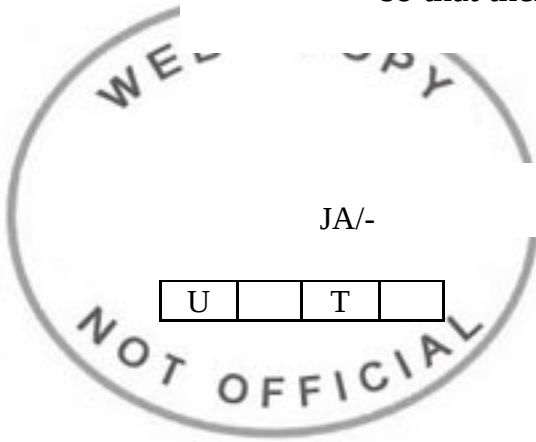
2. Having perused the Case Diary, I do not find any merit in the application.
