Although the representation filed by the petitioner before the District Magistrate (Annexure-4 series) does not invoke any statutory jurisdiction of the Authority, however, Mr. Prasad, Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the application be disposed of by directing the respondent District Magistrate to consider the petitioner's representation (Annexure-4 series).

Counsel for the State has also taken a stand that if there is any litigation concerning the land, the remedy is through the Civil Court or the appropriate forum.
