Heard both sides.

The petitioner is apprehending her arrest in a case under Sections 304(B)/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The informant alleged that his daughter was killed by her husband and other in-laws. The allegation of demand of dowry is against the husband of the deceased.

It is submitted that no specific allegation is made against the petitioner and the brothers-in-law of the deceased have already been enlarged on anticipatory bail vide order dated 16.01.2015 passed in Cr. Misc. No. 1892 of 2015.

Having considered the fact that the petitioner is the mother-in-law and the brothers-in-law of the deceased have already been enlarged on anticipatory bail on same and similar

facts, the above named petitioner, in the event of her arrest or surrender before the learned court below within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt / production of a copy of this order, is directed to be enlarged on bail on furnishing bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Smt. Kumari Khyati Singh, Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Patna in Kankarbagh P.S. Case No. 167 of 2014, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
