ORAL ORDER

3 25-05-2015 Heard learned counsel for the Petitioner and the State.

The Petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case
instituted for the offence under Sections 419, 420, 406, 120B and
504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

In view of the subsequent compromise between the
Parties, let the Petitioner in the event of surrender, named above,
within four weeks from the date of receipt of this order, in
connection with Mehsi P.S. Case No. 45 of 2014, be released on
anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.5,000/- (Five
thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each or any other
surety to be fixed by the Court concerned to the satisfaction of
Chief Judicial Magistrate, East Champaran at Motihari, subject to
the following conditions: (i) That one of the bailors will be a close

relative of the Petitioner who will give an affidavit giving genealogy as to how he is related with the Petitioner. The bailor will also undertake to inform the Court if there is any change in the address of the Petitioner. (ii) That the Petitioner will be well represented on each date and if he fails to do so on two consecutive dates, his bail will be liable to be cancelled.
