Heard learned counsels for the petitioner and the State.

The petitioner being the mother of the husband of the victim is apprehending arrest in a case registered for the offences punishable under Sections 302 and 120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

The accusation is of killing the daughter of the informant after 11-12 years of the marriage. It is alleged that the husband of the victim used to beat the daughter of the informant but when he went to Delhi to earn livelihood then other accused persons used to assault her. The postmortem report reflects the death due to asphyxia caused by hanging.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that there is no eye-witness to the occurrence and the thrust of accusation is against the husband of the victim.

Considering the fact that impugned order does not reflect any direct evidence against the petitioner, let the above named petitioner be released on anticipatory bail, in the event of arrest or surrender before the learned Court below within a period of 12 weeks from today, on furnishing bail bond of ₹10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned C.J.M., Araria in connection with Narpatganj (Ghurna O.P.) P.S. Case No. 285 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
