The name of the petitioner sprang up on the confession of co-accused.

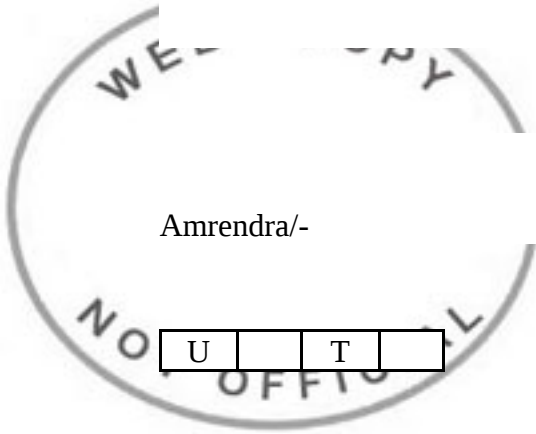
