ORAL ORDER

4 26-08-2015 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in a case instituted for the offences under Sections 498(A), 384, 307, 420 and 379 of the Indian Penal Code and Section 34 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner (husband) is ready to pay Rs.2,000/- per month to the opposite party no.2 (wife).

On the basis of the aforesaid commitment, in the event of arrest or surrender within four weeks from today, let

petitioner, namely, Ravi Shankar Kumar, be released on anticipatory bail on furnishing bail bonds of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Gaya in connection with Complaint Case No.2320 of 2013, subject to the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure with a rider that on each and every month the petitioner would pay Rs.2,000/- either in cash or through draft and cheque to opposite party no.2. In failure to make payment it will be deemed that bail would automatically be cancelled.
